City of Seattle Office of Housing – Fort Lawton Army Reserve Center Redevelopment

- The next step in the planning process will be the preparation of a Draft Environmental Impact Statement. This Draft EIS will be made public later this year, which will be followed by a 45-day public comment period and a public hearing. - In response to interest from Seattle Public Schools (SPS), the Office of Housing provided additional time for SPS to evaluate the site more closely, and determine whether it had a feasible path to include a school in the redevelopment.
